One of the challenges we have in cities is to find the connections between the different processes that affect our territory in a transversal way, and to look for integrative formulas in order to improve the sustainability of the urban habitat in a global way. The axes of the AUC seek to land the goals of sustainable development in the different aspects of the urban dimension. The current situation in COVID-19 has highlighted the importance of adapting urban habitats to technological impacts. In order to achieve a modern and advanced territory we need to incorporate new models of sustainable mobility, provide quality public transport, improve the efficiency of mobility infrastructures, reduce pollution from mobility and transport and adapt the urban habitats in digital disruption.
